Coldwater Public Library**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

An additional tax for the benefit of the Coldwater Public Library for the purpose of current operating expenses at a rate not exceeding one-half (0.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2014, first due in calendar year 2015.
